Instrumental and vocal tuition charging policy

From September 2024-2025

- All lessons taught by Tutors from NMPAT are charged at a rate of £93 for single (10 -min) lessons or £186 for double (20-min lessons) per term
- Piano lessons, taught by an Independent Tutor, are charged at £85 for single (10min) lessons or £170 for double (20-min lessons) per term.
- Each term is 11 weeks.
- Reduced fees are available for families who are currently eligible or have been entitled to Free School Meals in the past 6 years or are entitled to Pupil Premium.

Conditions of receiving lessons:

- Students are expected to attend at least one extra curricular musical activity during the week when they are at an appropriate standard
- Students are expected to practice regularly and attend their instrumental lessons

Notice period

If a student wishes to cease their tuition a <u>full term's notice is required</u> and <u>must be</u> <u>given in writing</u> to Mrs Wilson via hwilson@guilsborough.northants.sch.uk

- Deadline for Term 2: 1st Oct 2024
- Deadline for Term 3: 1st Feb 2025

Payment is required ahead of the start of each term, Term 1 due by mid– July, Term 2 by mid-November and Term 3 by mid-March.

Scheme to purchase an instruments

When do the lessons take place?

Instrumental lessons take place during the school day and, where possible, are run on a rota system timetable, so that students do not miss the same part of the same lesson or break each week. Static time lessons can be requested and will be accommodated when at all possible.

Where do the lessons take place?

All lessons are given in the music department.

How will students know when their lesson is?

The timetables for each instrumental teacher are displayed on the noticeboard in the music department.

Is there anywhere students can store their instrument?

There is an instrumental storeroom within the department where students can leave their instruments.

What do students do if they miss their lesson?

Try to speak to their instrumental teacher to arrange another time in the day, or speak to one of the music teachers, or Mrs Wilson in reception.

Will I be informed of my child's progress?

Detailed written report are provided during Summer Term., however if you wish to discuss your child's progress with your child's tutor prior to this, contact Mrs Wilson in reception who will put you in touch with them.

Is insurance needed?

Parents are responsible for ensuring that all instruments, including those on loan through the Northamptonshire Music and Performing Arts Trust, are covered for loss or theft etc. under appropriate insurance.

FEES for 2024-25

Payment for lessons is required in advance of the start of each term and one term's notice is required when cancelling lessons. This is because, as a school, we are required to book the lesson time with the music teachers in advance.

All lessons taught by Tutors from NMPAT (all except Piano) are charged at a rate of £93 for single (10-min) lessons or £186 for double (20-min lessons) per term

Piano lessons, taught by an Independent Tutor, are charged at £85 for single (10 -min) lessons or £170 for double (20-min lessons) per term.

Each term is 11 weeks.

Term One

For students starting at Guilsborough in September 2024, payment is required by 14 June 2024 via BACS. All subsequent payments will be made via ParentPay. For current student payment is required in July 2024 via ParentPay.

- Term Two Will be invoiced via ParentPay in October 2024.
- Term Three Will be invoiced via ParentPay in February 2025.

Notice period

- If a student wishes to cease their tuition a <u>full term's notice is required</u> and <u>must be given in writing</u> to Mrs Wilson.
- Deadline for Term 2: 1st Oct 2024
- Deadline for Term 3: 1st Feb 2025
