Unit Contents:

You will be able to explore, research and acquire techniques and develop your skills, knowledge and understanding in a wide range of Fine Art areas. You will explore Fine Art through the investigation and development of particular themes, ideas and genres.

Contemporary methods will also be investigated through lens based media and post editing using Photoshop and the Apple MacBook Pro.

The skills learnt in the introductory part of the course will enhance learning in the Coursework Portfolio beginning in January of Year 12 and the Set Task element beginning in the February of Year 13.

Progression:

This course can lead on, in the first instance, to the study of A2 Level Fine Art, then employment or training opportunities or further education in, for example, a one year art Foundation Course. This course is also suitable for those who plan to move on to higher education. Many and varied careers are available in the creative arts industries, design and architecture.
