# What is Child Sexual Exploitation?

- ▣ The sexual exploitation of children and young people is a form of child sexual abuse.
- ▣ It is a term for a range of negative sexual experiences that involve varying degrees of force or going against the will of the young person involved.
- ▣ This includes young people who have sex in exchange for drugs or somewhere to stay.

# The Grooming Process

- ▣ Vulnerable young person is targeted,
- ▣ Befriending and building trust
- ▣ Making the young person feel special and understood.
- ▣ Entering into a relationship,
- ▣ Building dependency while isolating them from their family/careers/school/peers.
- ▣ Gaining control of the young person, by manipulation, coercion, threats and intimidation.

# Methods of targeting

- ▣ Face to face/phone
- ▣ The Internet
- ▣ The party model
- ▣ Gang culture
- ▣ Trafficking

# Reading the Signs.....

- ▣ If a young person is being sexually exploited they may be doing some of these.....
- ▣ Receiving unexplained money and/or presents.
- ▣ Being discouraged from attending school.
- ▣ Going missing for a few days at a time.
- ▣ Going on the internet very late at night.
- ▣ Regularly seen in a different car.
- ▣ Being encouraged to be secretive & stay away from family & friends.
- ▣ Being encouraged to take drugs or alcohol to get drunk so that they loose control.
- ▣ Carrying around excessive amounts of condoms.
- ▣ Dressing provocatively or inappropriately.
- ▣ Associating socially with groups of older people.
