Dear Parent/Guardian,

We wish to invite your daughter/son to participate in our Celebration Day trip to Alton Towers. As a school, we would like to celebrate their commitment, efforts and completion of exams with a whole year group trip. Your child's inclusion on this trip is an acknowledgement of their hard work and recognition of their achievements during their time with us.

This trip is not essential to the National Curriculum but is intended to both encourage and reward students who have demonstrated their commitment to hard work. In order for the trip to be viable, it is necessary to ask for a voluntary parental contribution of £33.00, which includes the ticket for the entrance into the park and transport to and from the venue back to Guilsborough School. There is a limit on the spaces available, we will therefore require payment to secure a place on a first come first serve basis. The coach will leave Guilsborough School at 8:45am and return at approximately 5.30pm. Timings will be clarified on the day, depending on traffic, but students will need to be collected from school.

School uniform does not need to be worn. It is recommended that students bring some money for lunch, drinks or snacks, a maximum of £10. Alternatively, students may prefer to bring a packed lunch.

A Parental Consent Form is also attached to this letter. Please could this be completed and returned to me by Monday 22nd May, which is also the deadline for complete payment of the trip. Places are limited to 150, and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Where families are experiencing severe financial hardship, limited support may be available from the Governors' hardship fund for school excursions. Applications for hardship support should be made in writing, accompanied by evidence of any benefits received, to the Head teacher's PA, in advance of the excursion. Each case will be considered on its individual circumstances.

Parents should be aware that a high standard of behaviour is expected from all students taking part in this trip, for Health & Safety as well as social reasons, including the enjoyment of other party members. Parents of students whose conduct falls below this level may be asked to make arrangements to collect their children.
