Dear Parent/Carer,

I just wanted to take this opportunity to remind parents and students of the dress code policy within Guilsborough Academy Sixth Form. This policy was created through previous student voice who wanted a smarter dress code policy for the sixth form in July 2015. Students have had an assembly to remind them of the standards that we expect of them in sixth form in regards to their dress code. Our Year 12 students are now the oldest students in the school and therefore, it is important that these standards are maintained as they are role models to the younger students. Students should not be wearing strappy tops, polo shirts, trainers or jeans.

We have also made a slight change to the policy after some student voice regarding the wearing of shorts. Previously shorts have not be a part of the policy but we have reviewed this to allow students in Term 6 only (summer term) to wear smart tailored shorts only on very hot days if they wish. However, they must comply with the smart standards we expect such as tailored/chino type shorts plain in colour. Strictly no demin, board shorts or big patterns/slogans. In addition, shorts must follow the same length requirement as our skirt policy which is no shorter than 10 cm above the knee. Students must also maintain the standards expected in regards to tops and shoes when wearing shorts. No trainers, t-shirts or polo shirts allowed.

Lanyards are also a requirement and students must wear these at all times whilst on school site as they no longer have a uniformed dress code. Members of staff are also required to wear these along with visitors to ensure the safety of all the students within the school. These are also used for exams as students in post 16 education now need photographic ID for the exam invigilators to confirm their identify.

I have attached a reminder of the sixth form dress code. There are consequences in place for students who do not follow the required standards and in the first instance may be sent home to change if the standards are not being followed.
