- Gain recognition for your skills and experience

What sixth formers say.....

- Many students felt that the support they gave was beneficial to their students, that they made a positive contribution to the wider school.
- A particular highlight was the experience of working/helping other people which made mentors feel good about themselves
- personal advantages reported were improvements in communication skills, confidence in working with unfamiliar people, and extra skills for personal statement
- 56% of mentors said that have developed skills which will help them with their next steps
- The vast majority of students reported that communication was the main skill they developed from the programme
