


- To provide a personalised learning curriculum offering a range of pathways to maximise the potential of all students.

Quality of Education:

Through a robust quality assurance process, we aim to ensure that our students can access learning and fulfil progress expectations with subject specialist teaching. Assessment data will be used to inform timely and constructive intervention.

Behaviour and Attitudes:

We will deliver a behaviour curriculum that will secure classroom environments conducive to learning. Our behaviour recording and monitoring is effective and identifies next steps. We ensure that students feel safe at social times moving freely around the Academy. We expect and support attendance to be 96% or above.

Personal Development:

We continually seek further opportunities for personal development across the Academy to fully prepare our students for life beyond the Academy. British and Academy values will be embedded across the Academy as we develop our students' character. Increasing the number of initiatives to tackle bullying is key component of our development.

Leadership and Management:

We continue to develop the leadership and management skills of our senior leaders, investing in external experts to challenge the senior leadership team on the progress being made. Our independent consultant will be visiting the academy throughout the year to assess our progress on all the key areas listed above.

Sixth Form:

We will continue to build intervention programmes to support our students following each assessment point. Our tutor time programme will fully engage the students where they recognise the importance of the topic for the next stages of their journey through education or beyond. As we review our curriculum, we will consider carefully destination and labour market data to ensure we provide the most suitable options for our students.
