GHIC cards – worth getting, free (allow 15 days to receive)






What you need to bring

- Passports/Visas/GHICs
 - VALID!
- Food for first day (travelling)
 - Breakfast, lunch, and snacks
- Money
 - Spending money plus some for dinner/snacks on the journey home
 - Avoid bringing large amounts of cash
 - Check bank charges

 - Sketchbooks + pencils
 - Note books + pens
 - Camera/phone




Day 1

- 6:15am Check in at P&O Ferries Terminal, Dover
- 8:15am Ferry departs Dover
- 10:45am (local time) Ferry arrives in Calais
- 3:30pm Approximate arrival in Paris
- 4:30pm Cruise on River Seine
- 5.15pm Depart for Notre Dame area for sightseeing
- 7:30pm Dinner at Le Bossu
- 8:30pm Go to hotel



Day 2



- 8am Breakfast at the hotel
- 9:45am Visit to Musee d'Orsay
- 12:00pm Lunch and sightseeing around Champs Elysses
- 2:45pm Coach to take us to Pompidou Centre
- 6pm Visit to Montparnasse Tower
